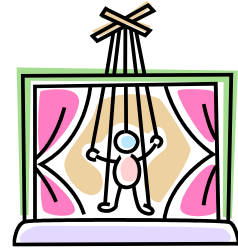

We performed the Fisherman and his Wife, A Moment with Grandpa, Little Red Riding Hood, a magic puppetry act, and The Johnny-Cake. The show went well. Frank received acknowledgement and appreciation note from the Ohio State Fair and thanked us for doing the shows.

Minutes from the September 21 Meeting.

Dave asked if anyone was going to Pokagon which is a regional meeting of puppeteers at Pokagon State Park in northern Indiana. It is held the first weekend of November from Friday 7 p.m. to Sunday noon. The cost is \$30 for the festival plus the cost of rooms at the lodge. Dave said they have worthwhile workshops and meetings. He especially remembered a workshop about painting backgrounds on silk. Dave also mentioned outlet malls nearby or going to the Puppet Theatre.

Next we talked about getting ready for *Dangerous Dan Steals Christmas*. We all wanted to rehearse after the October meeting.

As the theme for this year's guild meetings is "Putting Together a Show," Dave asked us to bring in possible puppet scripts for the guild to perform with our marionettes in the Spring. Richard mentioned the possibility of a Japanese Fairy Tale called *The Golden Axe*.

We have a tentative date of December 13 at 1:30 pm for the *Dangerous Dan Steals Christmas* show. Frank had said Mike Williams is willing to play Santa Claus pending review of script. We need to get him a copy of the script. The library would like a make-and-take craft but we are not obligated to do so. Rita had said the room is 30' by 60' and seats about 100-125 (with kids on the floor and adults in chairs). Richard, Janice, Dave, Beulah, Mike Williams and Frank have said they will perform the play.

Dave mentioned a company called puppetsforyou.com which has a nice foldable stage for hand puppets.

Connie motioned to adjourn the meeting, Janice seconded the motion.
